LockDown Browser Quick Reference

The following are the basic instructions for setting up and using the lockdown browser for quizzes in Schoology. Please follow carefully.

- 1. Create the test/quiz as you normally would in Schoology.
- 2. When it is ready click on the LockDown Browser option on the left menu. Workload Planning



- 3. Click on the "V" next to the test/quiz you want the students to take.
- 4. Click Settings.
- 5. Click on "Require Respondus LockDown Browser for this exam".
- 6. Click the "+" next to Advanced Settings.
- 7. At minimum you should have the first two boxes checked for locking students into the exam until complete and allowing students to use the iPad.
- 8. In addition, you should <u>always have a password</u> to close the browser in the event of a technology failure. This will allow the student to end the exam and re-enter to resume what they have completed.

 Once that is complete, make the quiz available <u>at least 15 minutes before having students take it</u>. If done in a shorter timeframe, students may have technical issues.

You do have other options like setting websites or using a calculator. But the settings above are going to be the most common for tests/quizzes using Schoology.
